2020-2021 INFORMATION

Welcome to Salvo Soccer Club. We are excited you will be a part of our club for the 2020-2021 season! Please read through this information packet carefully and use the checklist found on the last page to ensure that you complete all required items. TEAMSNAAP:

TeamSnap is an application our teams use to communicate important information throughout the season including practice times, game times, schedule updates, and cancellations. We also use this application to track attendance for practices and games.

You will receive an invitation to join your team on TeamSnap. If you do not already have a TeamSnap account, you will be asked to create one.

Jersey Number

Each player is assigned a jersey number by Salvo SC. You can find your child's assigned jersey number under the "Roster" tab. If you are using the app on the computer, the jersey number is to the left of your child's name. If you are using the app on your phone, the jersey number is below your child's name.

Photo

You will need to upload a headshot of your child to TeamSnap. This photo will be used for your child's player pass. Every player needs to have a player pass to participate in games and tournaments.

BIRTH CERTIFICATES:

Every player needs to have a birth certificate on file so we can order their player pass. Please send a copy of your birth certificate to registration@salvosoccer.org as soon as possible but no later than August 15 for fall teams and November 15 for spring teams.

UNIFORMS:

Read through this entire section before placing your order.

All Travel players will be in Salvo SC uniform kits. These kits include:

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*If your child is not a full-time goalkeeper, you will also need to order the navy jersey, orange jersey, navy short, navy socks, and orange socks.

You will need to purchase your child’s Salvo SC uniform kit from soccerloco. To do this, go to the [Salvo SC Team Room \(by clicking here\)](#) and create an account. Next, set up a new player kit and profile. 2011-2012 players select “U9/10 Teams”. 2009-2010 players select “Geos Teams” along with the appropriate gender. Enter your player’s first name, last name, and **jersey number assigned by Salvo SC**. Your child’s specific jersey number can be found on your TeamSnap account by going to the “Roster” tab of your child’s 2020-2021 team.

It is very important that you order jerseys with the number your child is assigned. **IF YOU ORDER JERSEYS WITH THE INCORRECT NUMBER, YOU WILL NEED TO PURCHASE ADDITIONAL JERSEYS WITH THE CORRECT NUMBER.** You will **NOT** be refunded for ordering jerseys with an incorrect number.

Uniforms must be ordered by August 15 for fall teams and November 11 for spring teams. You will NOT be able to order uniforms without your child’s assigned jersey number which will be available in your 2020-2021 TeamSnap account.

It is strongly recommended that you purchase base layers (to be worn underneath jerseys and shorts) for the cold fall and spring days. You can purchase base layers through soccerloco.

OPTIONAL SALVO SC GEAR

Salvo SC warmups and backpacks are optional items for our 2008-2011 Seasonal teams. These items are available for purchase through the [Salvo SC Team Room](#).

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

Your child will need the following equipment:

- Size 4 ball – properly inflated
- Ball pump
- Shin guards
- Comfortable cleats
- Water bottle

VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENT:

All Salvo SC Performance families are required to provide 5 hours of volunteer time per family during the soccer year or donate to the volunteer opt out fee. The soccer year is August 1 through July 31. The volunteer opt out fee for the 2020-2021 season is \$200.

If your family is participating in the fall season ONLY, your volunteer requirement is 2 hours.

FEES

Registration Fee

This is the fee you pay when you register your child to play on a team for Salvo SC. Registration fees are posted on our website [here](#).

The Fall registration fee includes:

- 2 contacts per week August-October (contacts include training sessions, games, classroom sessions, etc.)
- Weekly Goalkeeper Training
- Salvo SC Player Development Curriculum
- Club Registration
- USYS or US Club Registration & Pass
- League registration - MYSAs or TCSL

- Salvo SC Fall Classic tournament registration
- Uniform including one jersey, shorts, and socks
- A minimum of 1 player evaluation meeting with coach
- Monthly coach update communication coach update communication

The Spring registration fee includes:

- 2 contacts per week April-July (contacts include training sessions, games, classroom sessions, etc.)
- Weekly Goalkeeper Training
- Free Play opportunities throughout the course of the year
- Salvo SC Player Development Curriculum
- Club Registration
- USYS or US Club Registration & Pass
- League registration - MYSA or TCSL
- 1 Salvo SC Spring tournament registration
- A minimum of 1 player evaluation meeting with coach
- Monthly coach update communication coach update communication

Team Fee

Teams within Salvo Soccer Club will participate in events that are above and beyond the registration fee which will require families to pay a team fee. This is in addition to the club/registration fees. Team budgets will be set based on the expectations for each specific team as determined in cooperation by the director overseeing the team, the team coach and at times, family input. Team fees will be divided equally amongst all players on the roster. Team budgets will include but not be limited to tournament registration fees, winter league fees, coach travel expenses, field rental that is not included in the registration fees, etc. All team fees will be managed and processed by the club.

At the beginning of the year, a team budget is established and an estimated cost per player is determined. This fee is due at the time of registration.

At end of the season, the team manager and executive director will approve actual team expenses and credit/collect from families as needed.

Volunteer Fee

If your family chooses not to fulfill their volunteer requirement, a \$200 opt out fee will be assessed.

FALL SEASON:

Practices

Practices will begin the week of August 17. Your team's exact practice days and times will be determined by your coach with input from the team and your director and communicated to you the week of August 12.

Games

Games are played on the weekends (Friday-Sunday) and will begin August 28. Your team will be participating in the Twin Cities Soccer League (TCSL). TCSL will release your team's game schedule on August 18.

Tournaments

Your team will be participating in the Salvo Soccer Club Fall Classic tournament October 9-11 in Woodbury, MN. The cost for this tournament is included in your player registration fee. The game schedule for this tournament will be released approximately 1 week before the start date. Plan to play on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. PLAYER ID 2011 & 2012 TEAMS:

All 2011 & 2012 players who will be playing in the Spring need to attend Player ID in late October. Specific session information will be available in late September.

2009-2010 - If you indicated on your current Player ID registration that your child will be playing in the spring, you are registered for the October Player ID and do not need to do anything further.

If you indicated on your current Player ID registration that your child will only be playing in the fall, but your child wants to play in the spring as well, contact us at registration@salvosoccer.org and let us know. We will change your preferences and get you registered for the October Player ID.

WINTER SEASON:

Indoor Training (Optional)

Indoor Age Group Training/Inferno is optional for Seasonal players. Age Group Training/Inferno will begin in early November and continue through the month of March. The schedule and registration will be available on the [Winter Training](#) page of our website in October.

Winter League (Optional)

Participating in a winter league is optional for Seasonal teams. Your team is welcome to participate in a league if the team chooses. For more information about winter leagues, please contact your coach or director.

Tournaments (Optional)

Salvo SC offers 3v3 tournaments over the winter months. These tournaments are fun and allow the players the opportunity to lead their team - no coach needed. Games are 20 minutes long with 2 minute halves and there is a 3-game guarantee. Watch the [tournament](#) page of our website for more information.

SPRING SEASON:

Practices

Teams will begin practicing indoors in early April. Your team's practice days and times will be determined by Salvo SC staff and communicated to you in late March.

Outdoor practices will begin in May. Your team's exact practice days and times will be determined by your director and communicated to you in late April.

Games

Games may be played on any day of the week and will begin in May. Your team will be participating in the Twin Cities Soccer League (TCSL). TCSL will release your team's game schedule in April.

Tournaments

Your team will be participating in one of two Salvo Soccer Club tournaments and two additional local tournaments. The cost of the Salvo SC tournament is included in your registration fee.

Tournaments your team attends will be chosen by the coach with input from the team and your director.

CLUB BREAKS:

Salvo Soccer Club will take three club-wide breaks throughout the soccer year. During these breaks, the Salvo SC offices will be closed and all teams and staff are strongly encouraged to take time off. Any communication we receive during these times, will be answered upon our return.

- Winter Break: December 21-January 1
- 4th of July Break: June 27-July 4

The Salvo SC offices will also be closed the following days:

TEAM PICTURES:

Team photos will be taken in April. All players are required to get their picture taken but not required to purchase photos. More information will be communicated to you in late March/early April.

TEAM BUILDING

High School Soccer Community Nights

There will be opportunities available throughout the fall months for Salvo SC players to attend high school soccer games for free if they are wearing their Salvo SC jersey. More information will be communicated through our weekly newsletters as it becomes available.

Ball Kids for High School Games
